## THE SCHOLARSHIPS

Twice a year the MAV offers a scholarship for a current Victorian Councillor to attend the Cranlana Colloquium. The scholarship is subject to an application process coordinated by the MAV and valued at \$5000. The next Colloquium the MAV is offering a scholarship to will run from Sunday 16 to Friday 21 May 2010.

## THE COLLOQUIUM

The Colloquium is the central activity of The Cranlana Programme, Conducted by the Myer Foundation, a non-political, not-for-profit organisation. The Colloquium is a week-long seminar offered to groups of approximately 20 participants, drawn from the public, private and not-for-profit sectors. The Colloquium enables participants to define and understand the principles that lie at the heart of leadership and decision making. Participants leave better able to think through issues, to integrate new and different perspectives and to communicate with and motivate people.

Successful applicants will need to attend each day of the Colloquium and be available each evening. Approximately 10 hours of preparatory reading is also required. Participants will need to arrange their own accommodation, the sessions are held in Toorak.

## HOW TO APPLY

Applicants are asked to submit a current résumé and a written proposal of not more than 500 words that address:

- What you think you will gain from the Colloquium and how you will apply it in the wider context of your work and life: and
- Your philosophy and approach to leadership and how it has been shaped by your experiences in local government.
