

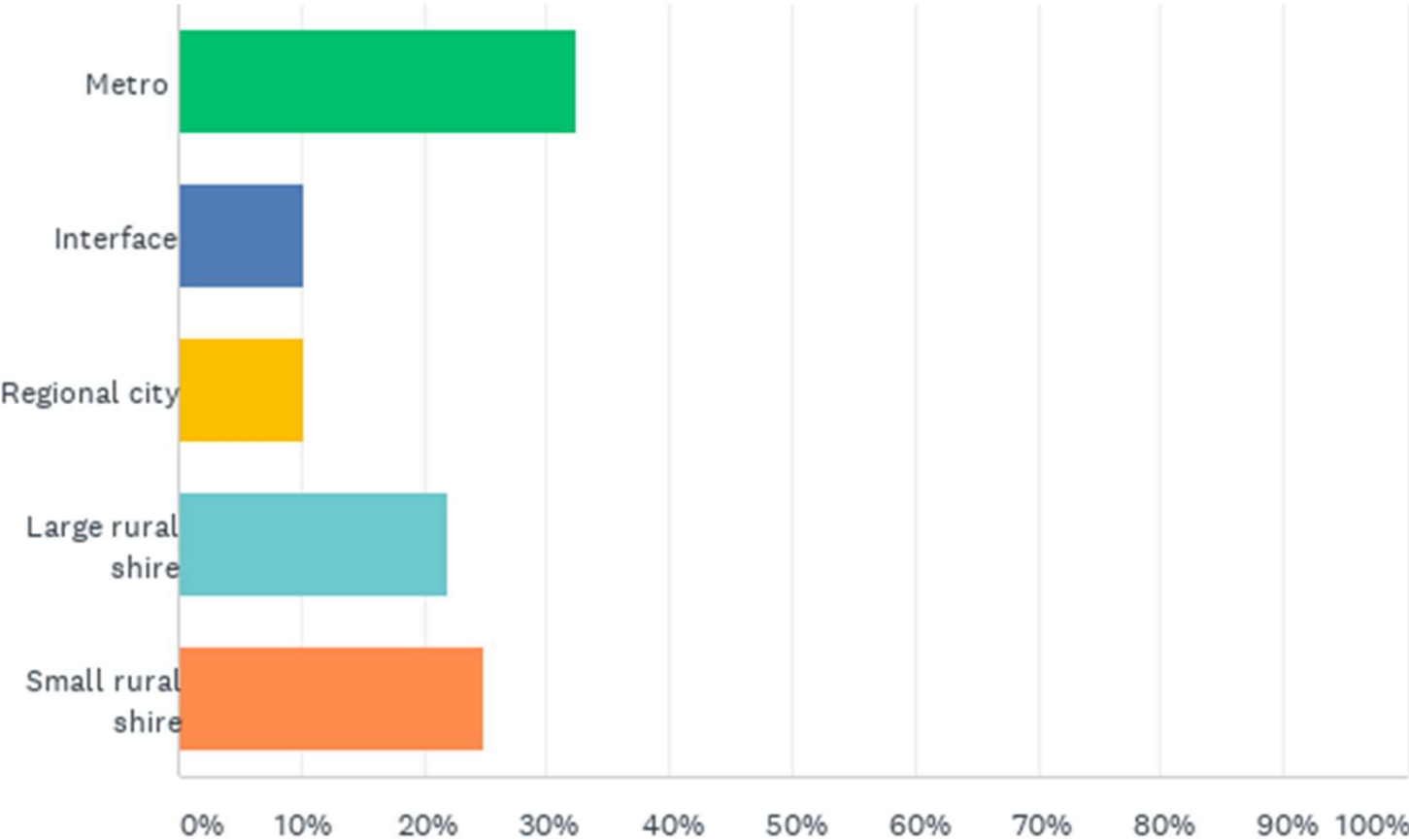

Q2: Type of council

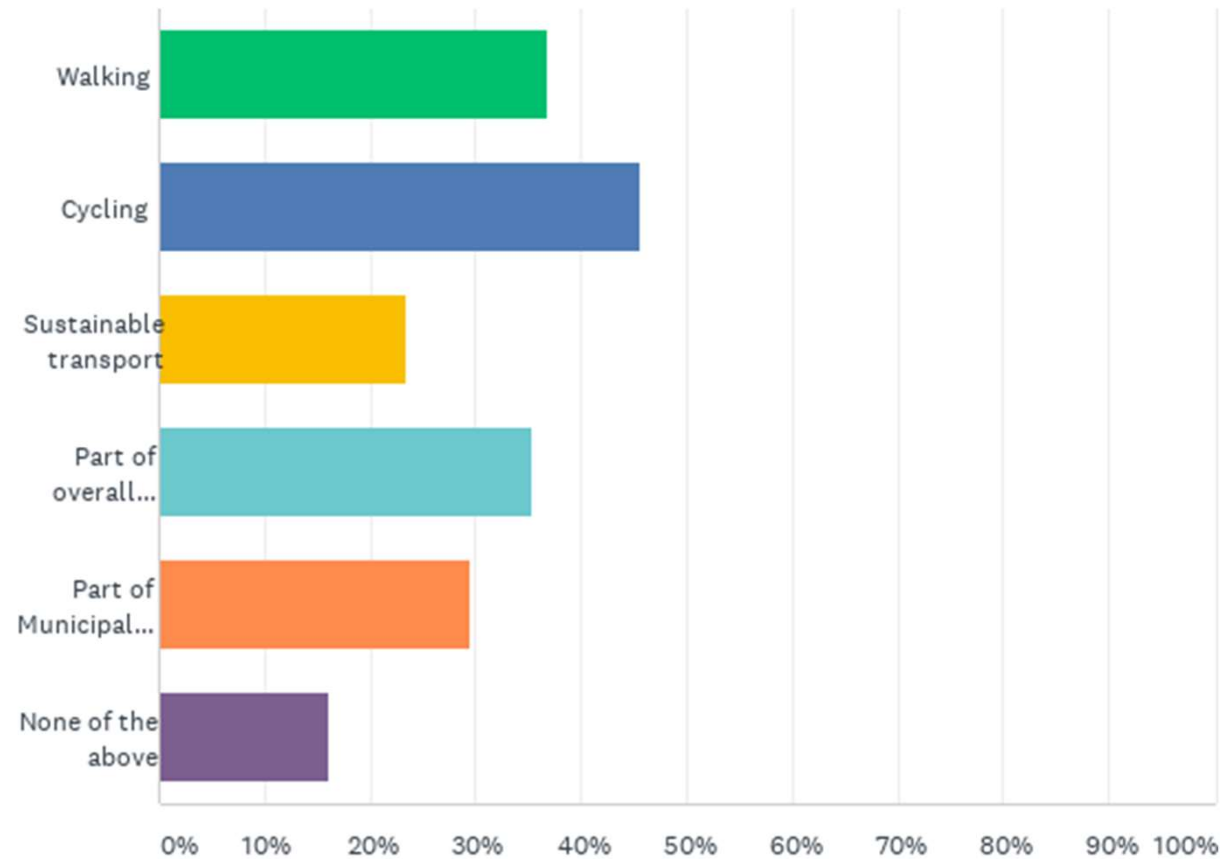

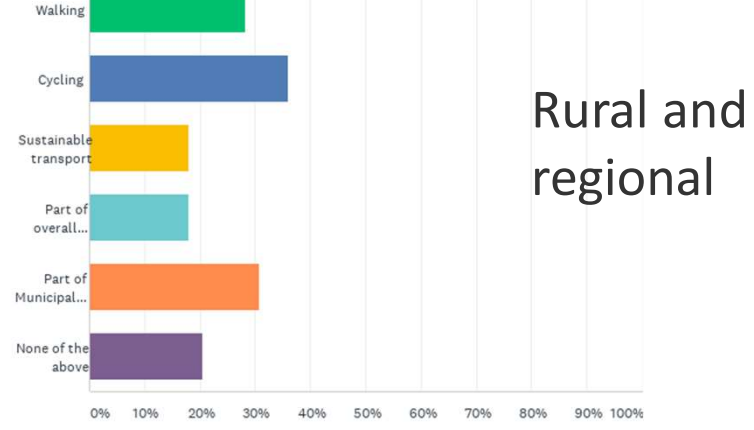

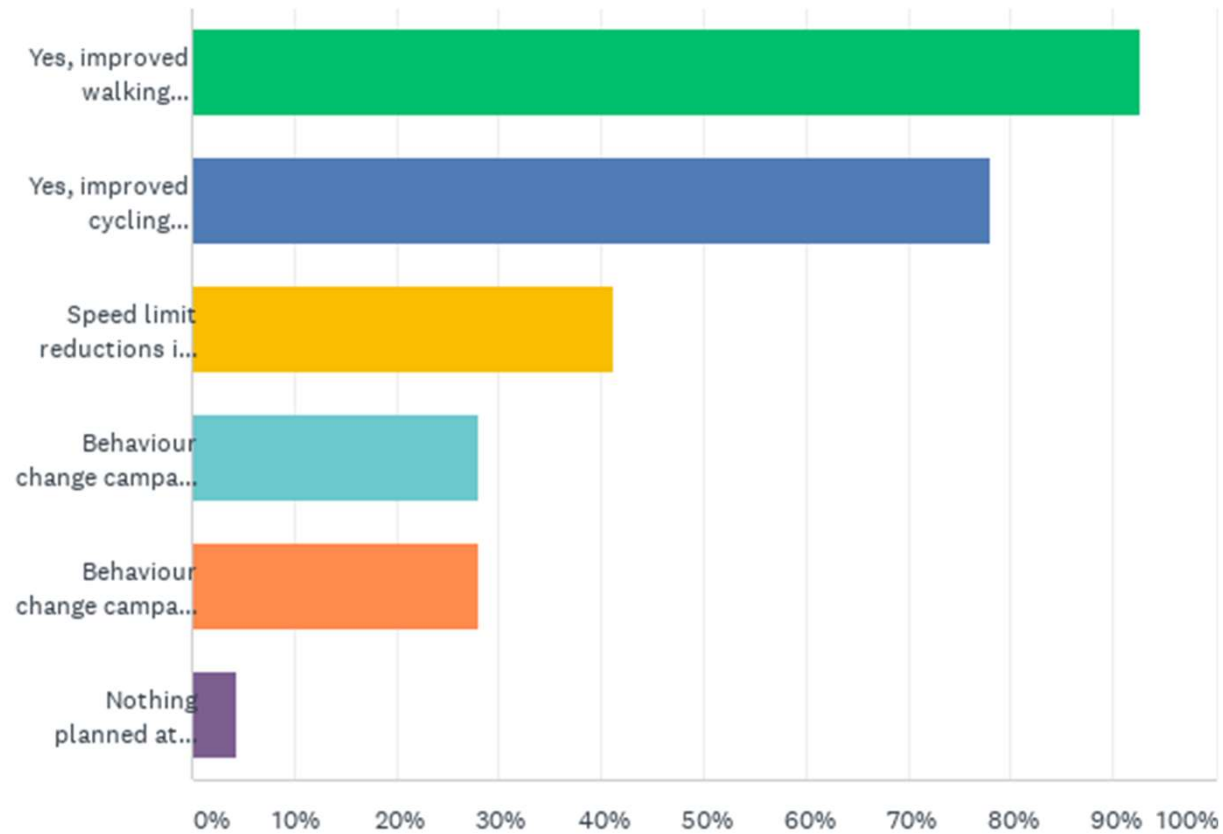

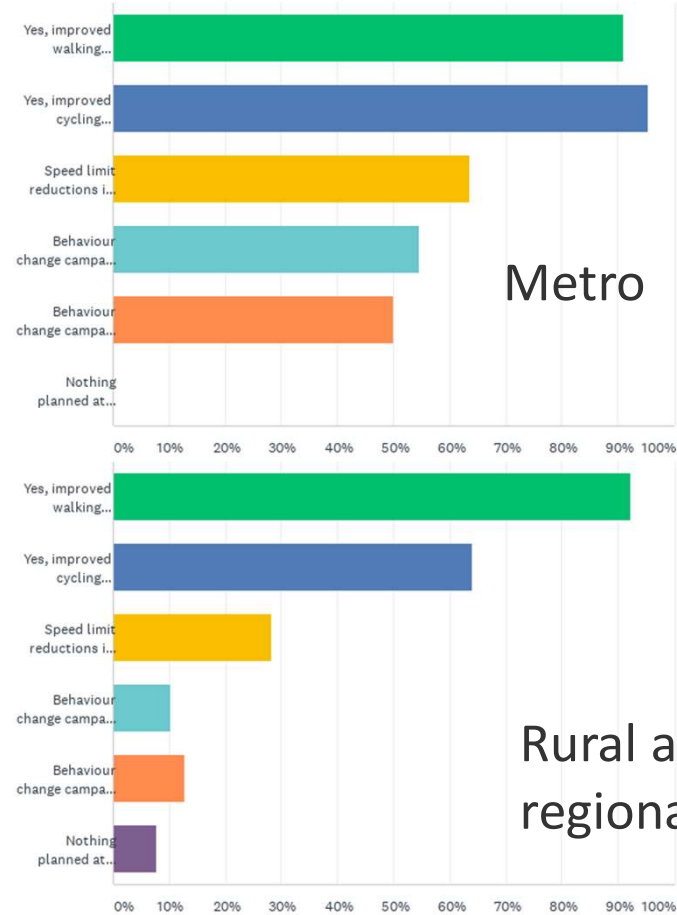
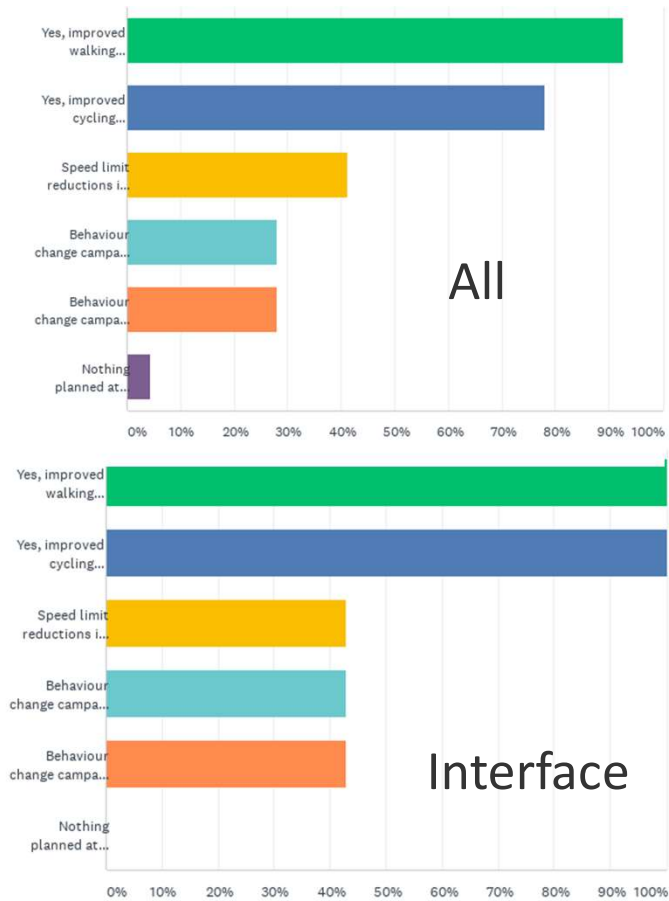

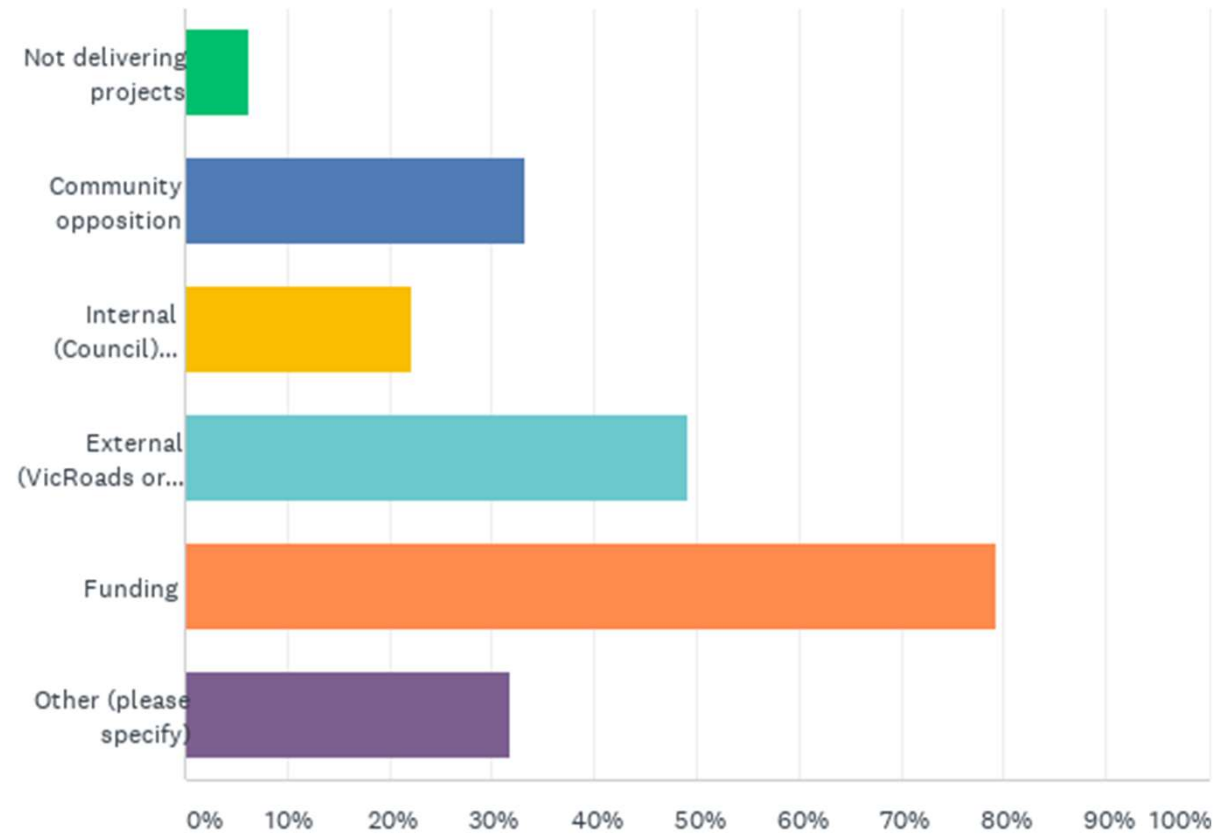

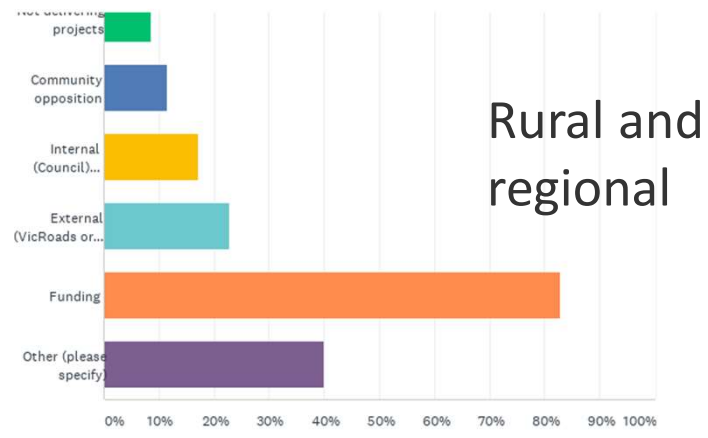

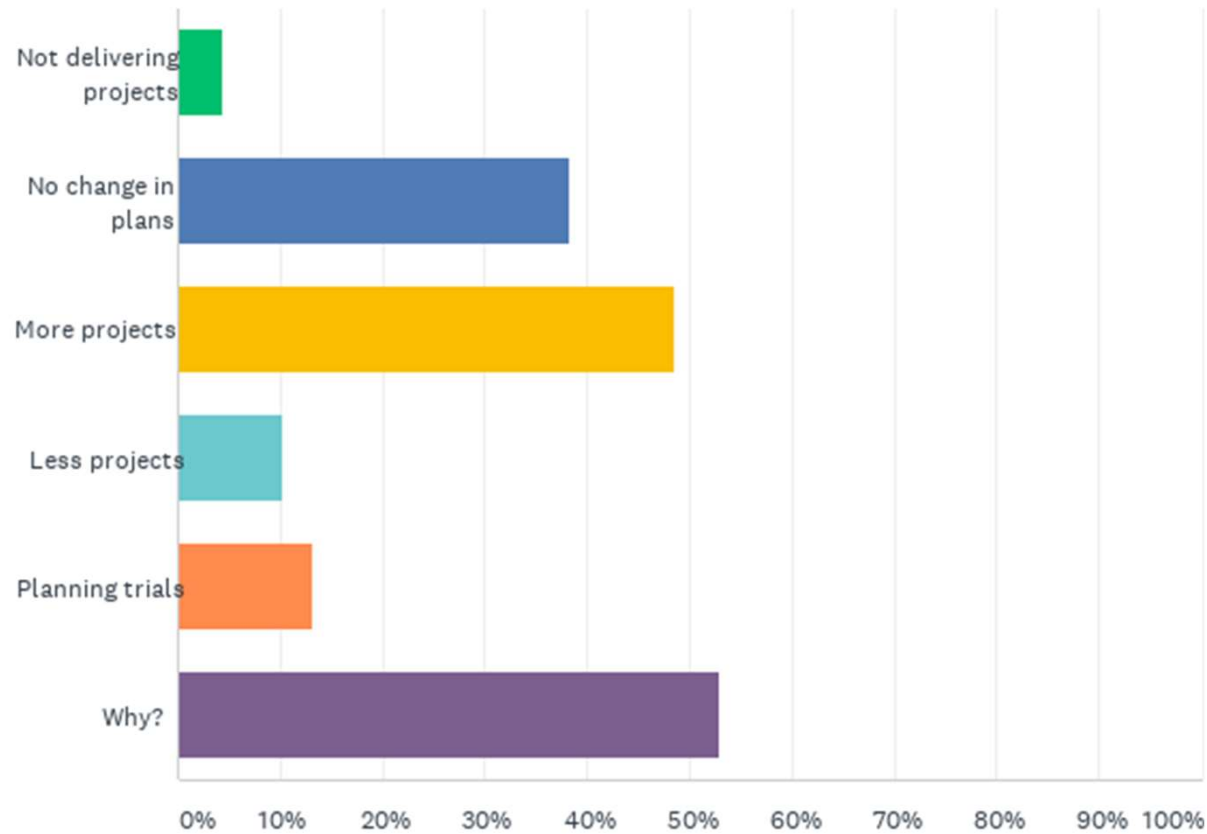
