The event will be held at **Myuna Farm, 182 Kidds Road, Doveton**.

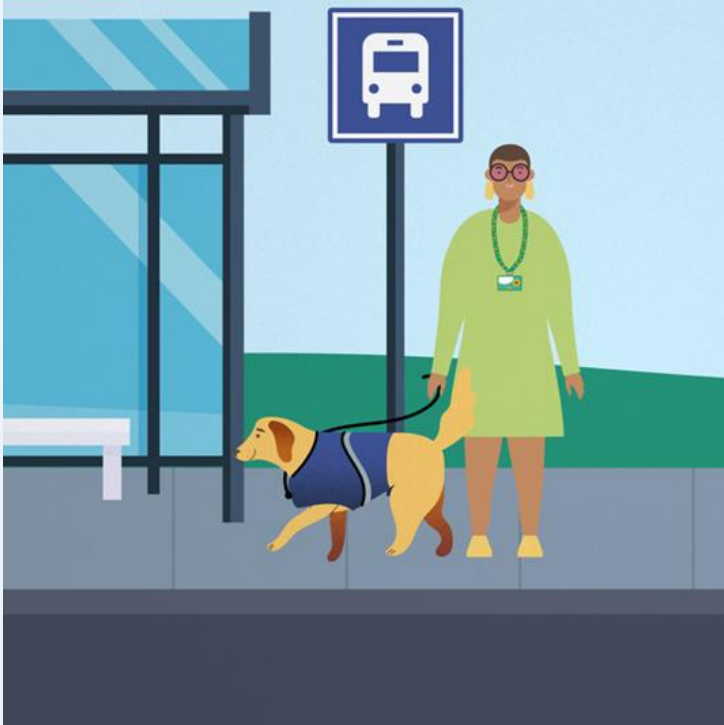
This **Access Guide** helps you know what to expect when you arrive, move around, and enjoy the event.

Getting There and Parking

Myuna Farm is easy to find and close to public transport.

- **Address:** 182 Kiddy Road, Doveton.
- **Buses:** Routes 843, 845 and 982 stop at the Betula Street / Kiddy Road bus stop near entrance.
- **Driving:** Enter from Kiddy Road and follow the driveway to the carpark.

Accessible parking:

- **Disability parking** is close to the main entrance (around 20 metres).
- A **drop-off point** is available in front of the Farm Office (no parking).
- **Additional carpark** at Robert Booth Pavillion - Clow Street, Dandenong (600m walk to Myuna Farm).

Traffic Marshalls will help guide you to parking.

Getting There and Parking



People with **mobility issues** and **Disabled Parking Permit** will be prioritised for the Myuna Farm carpark.

Overflow parking will be at **Robert Booth Reserve** (see map above)



Entry and Check-In

You'll see large wooden doors at the barn-style building at the end of the carpark.

- Have your **ticket ready** on your **phone** or printed copy.
- Staff and volunteers will greet you in the queue to check your **tickets**, answer questions, or direct you to support.
- **Accredited assistance animals** with a **vest** are welcome.

There is a queueing system and there may be a small wait at the start of the event. If you need a **quiet or quick entry**, let a volunteer know.



Entering the Event

As you walk in:

- The ground is **flat concrete** or **compacted gravel**.
- You'll see **festoon lights** along the pathway.
- You may hear **music, people talking**, and the **sounds of animals** in the distance.
- The playground is on your **right**, and you'll soon see the **main stage** area ahead.



Main Stage

The main stage will host **performances** throughout the evening, including:

- **Hey Dee Ho**
- **Ubute Ukele Group**
- **Charlie Silly Pants**
- **Beyond Rhythm Band**
- **Amina and Nick**

You can watch from the **grassed area** or sit at nearby **picnic tables**.

The stage will have **amplified sound**, but volunteers can help you find a quieter viewing spot.



Food

Food trucks will be located beside the stage area. Options include:

- **Pertruccelli Pizza**
- **Chillie Express Melbourne**
- **Mr Fresh Truck**
- **Kombeans**
- **OMG Decadent Donuts**
- **AJS Wonder Whippy**

Both cash and card accepted.

You are welcome to bring your own food.



Animal Nursery

The Animal Nursery is an enclosed space where you can see **small animals** like rabbits and guinea pigs.

There are **no steps**, entry is through a **wide doorway** with a gentle **ramp**.

Staff can assist if you to see the animals.

Please **do not feed** or **pick up** animals.

Service animals must remain outside this space.



Tractor Rides

The **tractor ride** is suitable for the whole family to enjoy.

The tractor pulls **carriages**, acting as a train. The tractor completes a **circuit** following along the paddock feed trail and down to the wetlands.

The circuit takes **10-15 minutes** and there are no stops.

There is a wheelchair accessible carriage available, with limited rides offered on a first come first served basis.

Rides are **limited**, be quick.



Face Painting

Nearby is the activity zone, which includes:

- **Face and arm painting**
- **Face and arm stamping** (a quick easy way to enjoy the fun)

Volunteers will be there to help with communication, waiting times, or guiding participants to quieter spaces.



Roving Performers

There will be roving performers, including:

- **Giant bubbles**
- **Wildlife**
- **Transformers**

Performers will move around different areas of the event throughout the evening.

Some performers may make **sounds**, use **props**, or **move close** to the crowd.

You can enjoy the performances from a distance if you prefer.



Sensory Space

These areas are designed for **rest** and **regulation**.

There will be a **Quiet Space** and a **Sensory Space**.

The spaces are designed to support all **seven senses**: sight, sound, touch, taste, smell, balance, and body awareness.

It's a calm and welcoming area where you can take a break if you need to.

Friendly **Neuro-Affirming Angels** will be there to offer gentle, personalised support.



Disability Expo

Visit the **Disability Services Expo**, located in the **large barn**.

You'll experience a mix of **sights, sounds, and smells**.

Expect lots of **friendly voices, busy chatter**, and community **energy**.

You can meet **local service providers** and **council teams** from Casey, Greater Dandenong, and Cardinia, who are ready to share **helpful information** and chat about **supports** and **services** in your area.

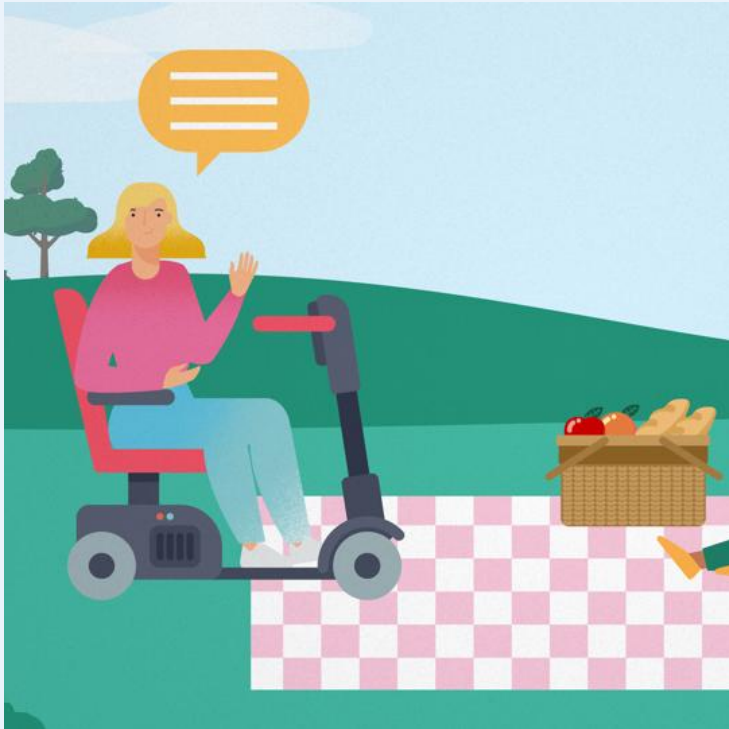


Toilets

Accessible toilets are located in the **Pavilion** near the Quiet/Sensory Space.

- The **Changing Places** facility includes height-adjustable change table, hoist, and adult-size space for two carers.
- **Accessible portable toilets** are available in the outer zone near the back paddock

Volunteers can direct you if you need help finding facilities.



Resting and Seating Areas

There are many **spots to rest** throughout the event.

- Wheelchair-accessible **picnic tables** near the entry and food area.
- Additional **seating** near the playground and stage.
- **Benches** and quiet corners available around the pathways.

Tip: Bring a **rug** if you prefer sitting on the grass.



Service Animals

Accredited assistance animals are welcome.

Must remain on a **harness** or **leash** and stay on designated paths.

For safety, service animals cannot enter the animal **nursery** or **kangaroo paddock**.

There will be a designated '**break space**' for service animals near the portable accessible toilets.



First Aid

First Aid is provided by **Medical Edge Australia**.

They will be **located** at the **entry of the Farm** in the unlikely event first aid is required.

If you need assistance, please ask a **volunteer** in a **bright pink vest**.



Help and Assistance

You will see people wearing **bright pink vests**.

They can provide **directions** and answer access **questions**.

Volunteers have completed **disability awareness training**.
