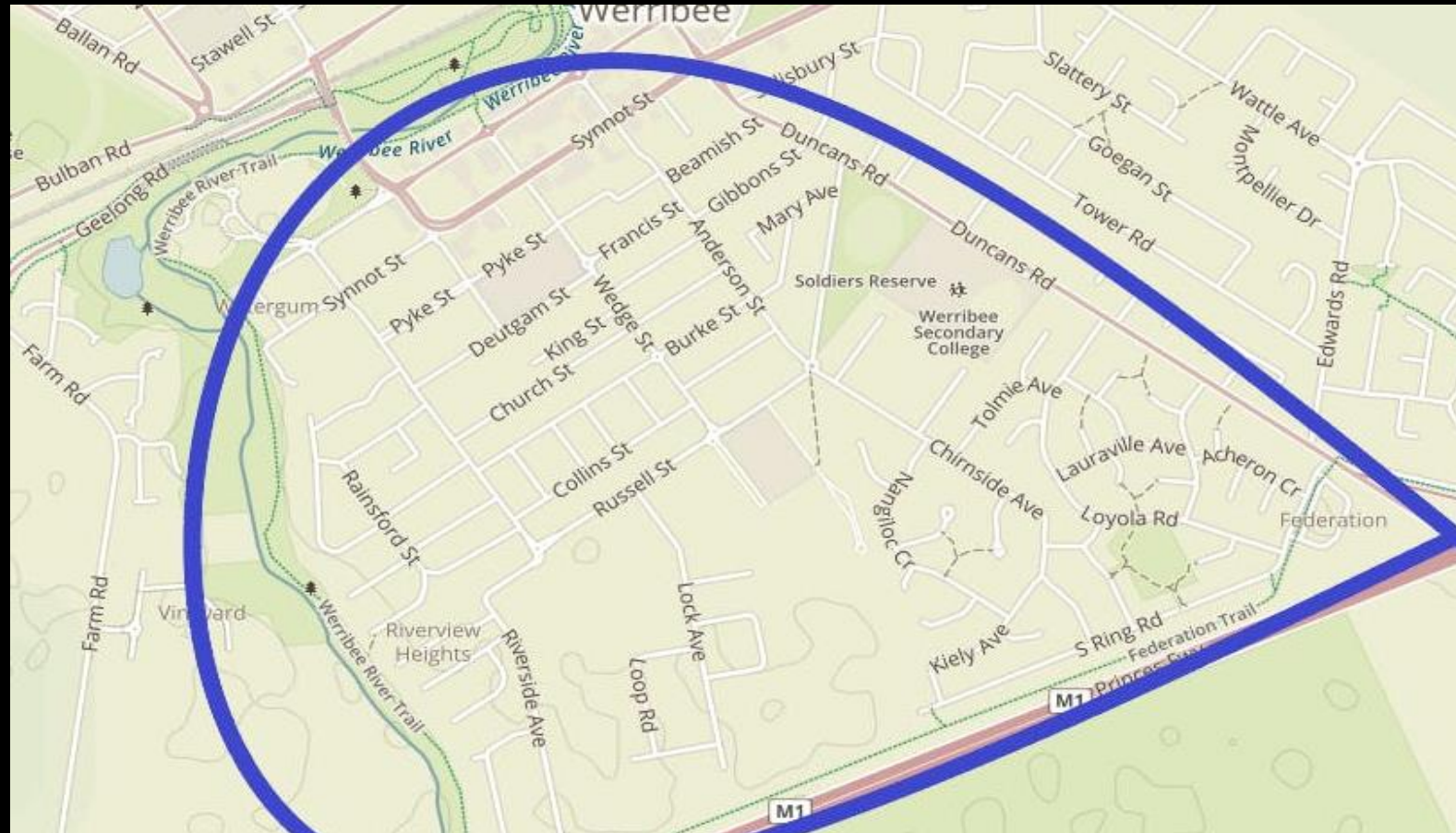

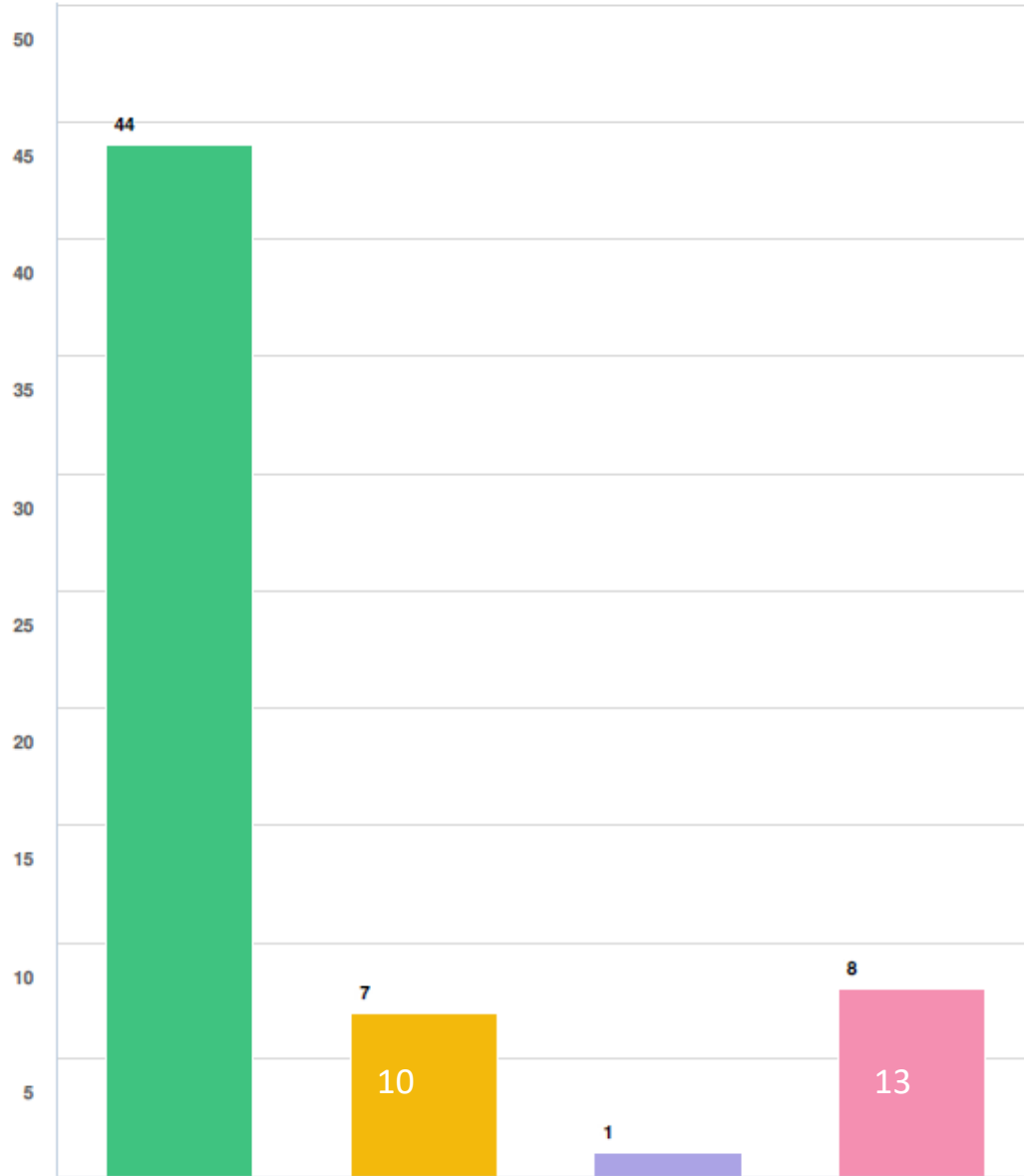

To what extent would you support pop up shared zones for active travel and exercise in your neighbourhood?

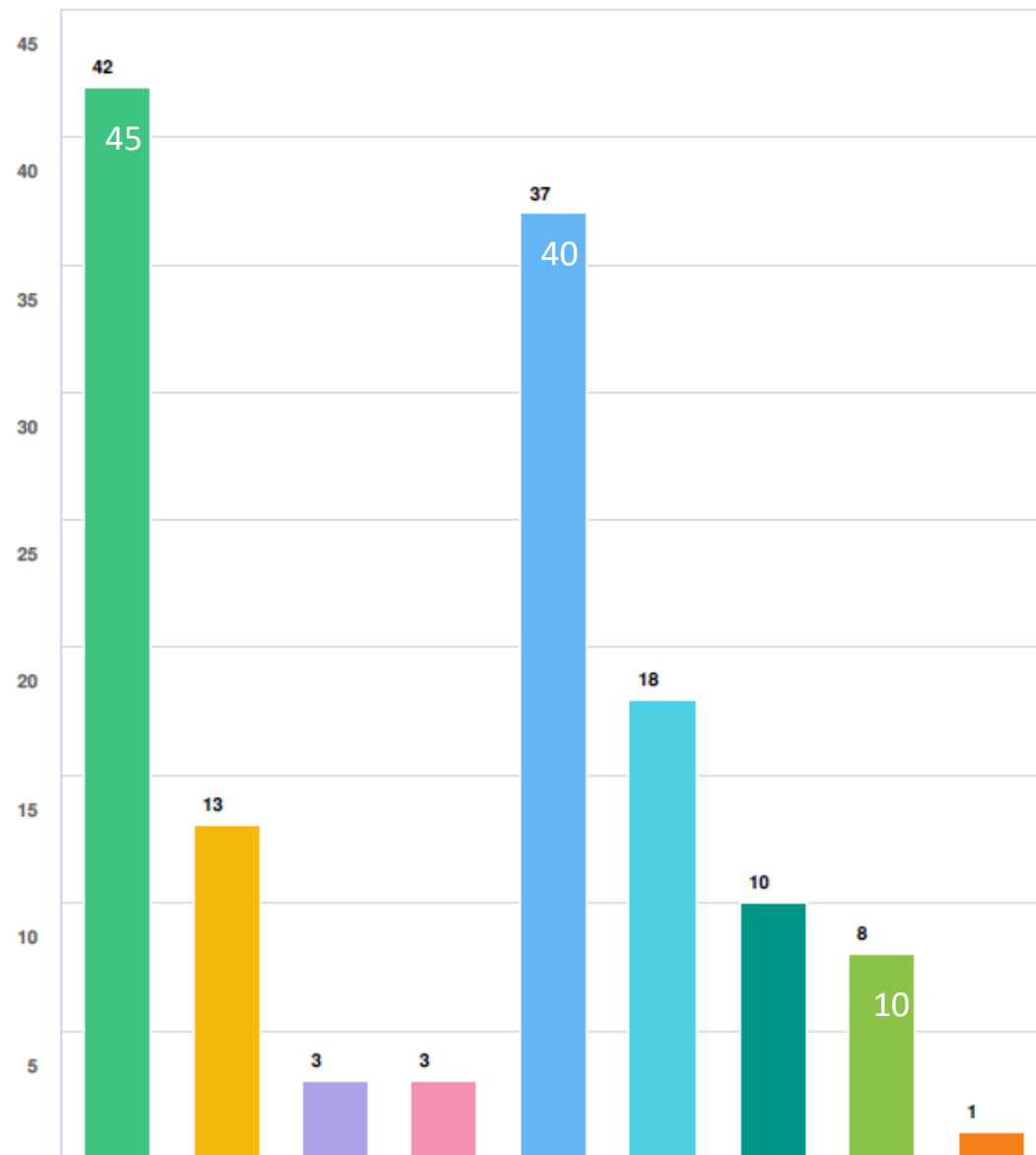

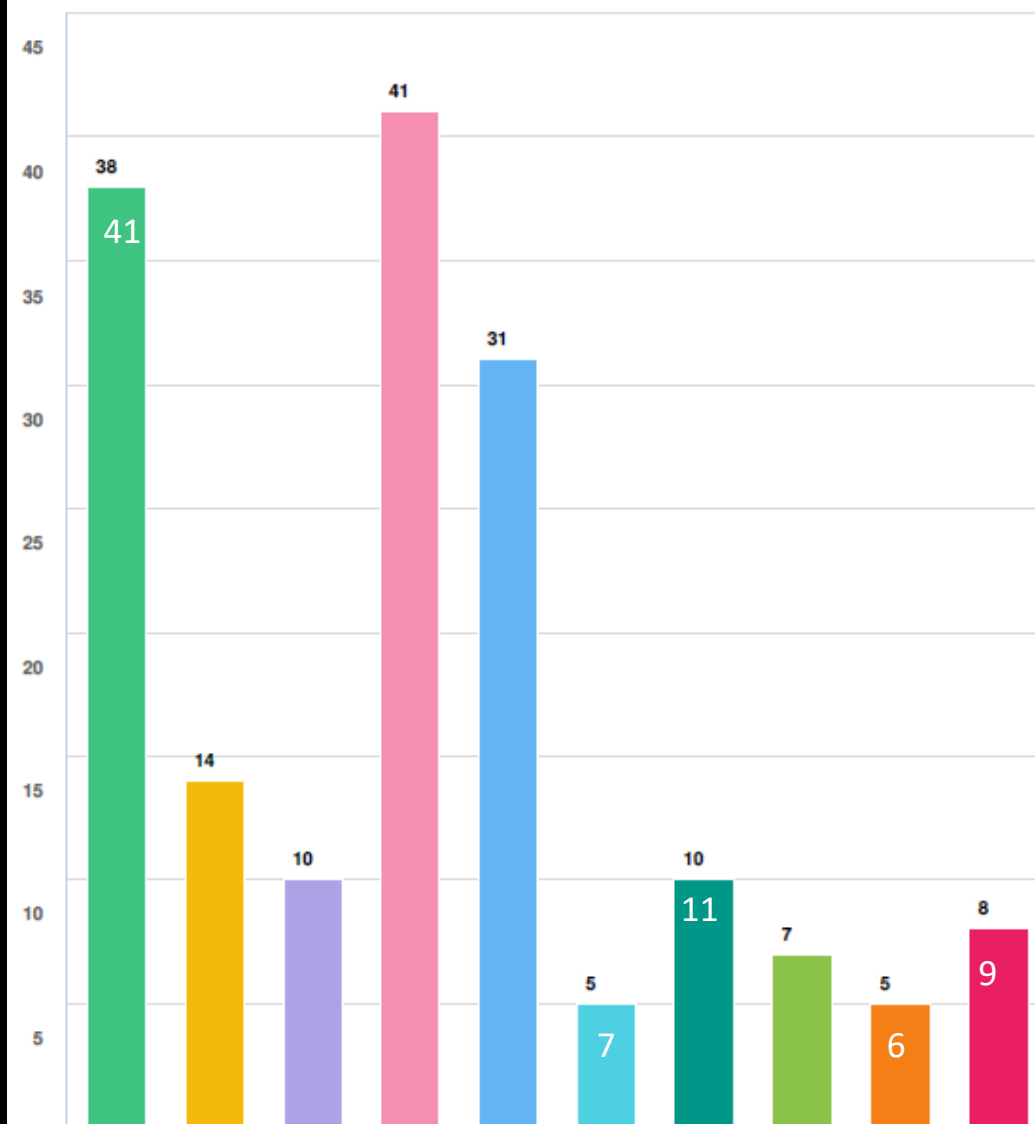

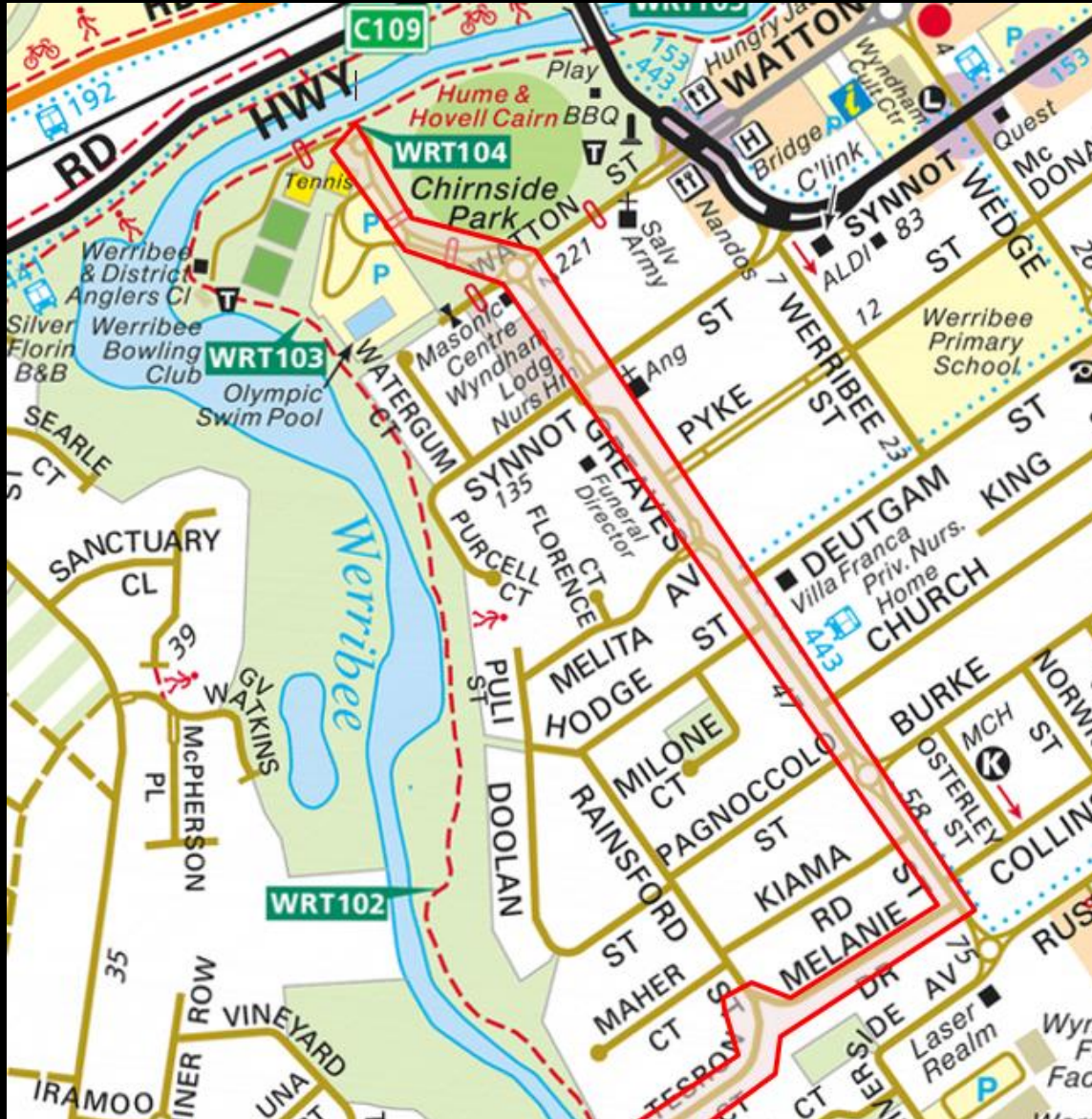
