Why a new Policy Template?


- Aligns with the 2024 Best Practice Procurement Guidelines
- Supports Council's with policy reviews under the Local Government Act 2020
- Responds to strong sector demand for clarity, consistency and flexibility
- Designed and Built for use by all 79 Victorian councils





What makes this Template different?

- Customer-centric layout for easier navigation
- Strategic, not prescriptive: focuses on the "why," not the granular "how"
- Fully compliant with the LG Act 2020
- Editable appendices for quick customisation
- A base for future MAV tools and templates





Built for Council Customisation

Orange prompts show where to insert council-specific settings.

Appendices make it easy to drop in:

- Thresholds
- Delegations
- Exemption justifications
- Contract variation rules
- KPIs and QBL measures

Update once, not throughout the whole document






Addressing Sector Feedback

Refinements made based on council engagement:

- Clearer definitions (e.g. Panel Contracts, Sole Sourcing)
- Inclusion of Caretaker Period guidance
- Default GST-excluded thresholds for easier budgeting
- Practical application of Value for Money & QBL principles
- Rules for Panel Contract management clarified
